As our students get older, it becomes important to work on their independent living skills. Some of our students may need technology to help them get things done, manage their money, and manage their time. Check out these resources from a recent training from Pacer Center, Apps to Support Independent Living. The CanPlan app makes it possible to break down virtually any task into a sequence of easy-to-follow photos. Goblin Tools has a free website or \$1.99 app that helps break down tasks into steps on a checklist. It also has an Estimator tool that will estimate the amount of time for an activity. The Time Timer App is similar to what students may use in school to help them understand how much time they have for a task. Finally, Monefy is an easy-to-use colorful app to track income and spending by week or month. You can do more with the paid Pro version, but it's worth checking out!
